Good grades and athletic talent are not the only things that can help pay your way through college – simply being a good person can also earn you a scholarship. The Hale County Community Foundation Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who, in some way, demonstrates good personal character, leadership or strong moral fiber, through a specific act or through long-term commitment to the community. Applicants must demonstrate moral and intellectual qualities, honesty, integrity, selflessness, acceptance of others, concern for others, character, leadership, citizenship, compassion and a general spirit of good will.
